Awarding High School Diplomas to Veterans of World War II

Section 10-221a(g) of the Connecticut General Statutes provides for the following:

“A local or regional board of education may award a diploma to a veteran of World War II pursuant to section 27-103, as amended, who left high school prior to graduation in order to serve in the armed forces of the United States and did not receive a diploma as a consequence of such service.”

A veteran is defined in Section 27-103 as any person honorably discharged from or released under honorable conditions from active service in the armed forces.

Section 10-221a(g) is designed to recognize the sacrifices made by our World War II veterans by granting them diplomas not received as a direct result of their military service.

The Ansonia Board of Education will grant diplomas to veterans of World War II who qualify according to the criteria set forth above. Veterans or relatives who wish to have a degree awarded posthumously should contact the Superintendent's office at the Ansonia Board of Education Administration Building to obtain and complete the application.
